Common Rules

If my ball lands in a water hazard, I can

- a) Play the ball as it lies without penalty
- b) Play another ball from the original spot with a 1 stroke penalty
- c) Drop within 2 club lengths of where it crossed the water hazard with a 1 stroke penalty
- d) Drop a ball as far back from the water hazard by keeping the point of entry in line with the hole
- e) Any of the above

If my balls lands out of bounds (OB) I can:

- a) Drop a ball where it went out of bounds and add 2 strokes
- b) Play another ball from the original spot with a 1 stroke penalty
- c) Either of the above

I can take a practice swing in a bunker and brush the sand: Yes or No

I can move leaves or sticks in a bunker if they are in the way of my swing or ball: Yes or No

I can move my ball without penalty if it lands near a tree: Yes or No

I can move my ball without penalty if it lands near a wall that is the boundary of the course:
Yes or No

I can move my ball if it stops on the cart path:

- a) Yes, I can drop my ball within one club-length no nearer the hole without penalty
- b) No

I can declare my ball Unplayable at any time on the course except when my ball is in a hazard:
Yes or No

If my ball is Unplayable, I can:

- a) Play another ball from the original spot with a 1 stroke penalty
- b) Drop within 2 club lengths of where it lies, no closer to the hole with a 1 stroke penalty
- c) Drop a ball as far back from where the ball lay, keeping that point directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped with a 1 stroke penalty
- d) Any of the above

Rules and Pace of Play Test

If I accidentally move my ball I:

- a) Play it where it ends up with no penalty
- b) I move it back to where it was with a 1 stroke penalty

If I accidentally bump my ball off the tee before I tee off:

- a) Place it back on the tee with no penalty
- b) Play it where it lies with a 1 stroke penalty

If another player accidentally moves my ball I:

- a) Play it where it ends up with no penalty
- b) I move it back to where it was with no stroke penalty

Pace of Play

FAST means that you move quickly between shots. Hit the ball and get out of the way. Keep up with the group in front of you at all times – even if this means no practice swings.

SAFE means that you don't endanger others with your club or ball. Know what you are doing and watch what you are doing.
